# Welcome Back Strings Students!

I am very excited about the 2011-2012 school year and the Conder Strings Program! I hope you will continue to be a part of the strings program this year.

The schedule this year will be very different from previous years.

All strings classes will be held during school hours instead of afterschool.

This change will help us avoid conflicts with the many afterschool programs Conder offers.

Students will have Strings two days a week - 1 small group lesson and 1 large group class.

More specific information can be read below.

#### Small Group Lesson

Students will have a 30 minute small group lesson each week.

Students will be pulled from their academic class time to attend their lesson.

(If they forget their violin, students will NOT be pulled from academic class time for their lesson)

Students are required to make-up the work they miss in their academic class due to their lesson.

Students must maintain a C average in academic areas in order to attend their weekly lesson.

Students will be grouped based on skill level when scheduling small group lessons.

## Large Group Class

Students will have a 40 minute large group class each week.

Students will be pulled from their Encore class time 1 day a week to attend their Strings class.

Large group classes will be grouped based on grade level when scheduling.

Students are required to attend their large group class whether or not they have their violin that day.

### **Benefits of the New Schedule**

Small group lessons allow for individualized instruction to meet the diverse needs of each student. Students will **NOT** consistently miss any Encore class or 'give up' a specific Encore class to attend Strings. Our schedule will no longer conflict with other afterschool programs offered at Conder! The schedule is easy to remember! Students have 2 days a week they will need to bring their violin for Strings. By requiring a C average in academic areas, we will emphasize the importance of academics paired with the arts.

Research shows that students involved in pull-out music programs perform at the same level or higher academically.
