# Conder Strings Program

#### **General Information**

The Conder String program is offered to interested students in 1st-5th grades.

All Strings classes are taught by a full-time certified Strings teacher.

Entrance into the strings program is only offered at the beginning of the school year.

A two week trial period is used to assess students' motor skills/classroom conduct before being accepted into the program. Students who are accepted into the Strings program will be responsible for further package and rental fees (see below). All 1st year Strings students will perform in the Spring concert (more specific details will be given in the Spring).

### **Schedule and Academic Requirements**

Students who are accepted into the Strings program after the 2 week trial period will attend Strings class 2 days a week.

Students will be pulled from academic class time 30 minutes a week for a small group lesson.

Students will be required to make-up any academic work they miss due to their lesson.

Students must maintain a C average in academic areas in order to attend their weekly lesson.

Students will also be pulled from their Encore class 1 day a week for a large group Strings class.

Students will NOT consistently miss any Encore class or 'give up' a specific Encore class to attend Strings.

#### Goals

During their first year in the Conder Strings program, students will learn:

Correct body, instrument, and hand positions when playing violin

Basic music symbols and violin terminology

Simple note and rhythm reading

Concert and performance etiquette

#### **Financial Responsibilty**

(if accepted into the program)

- 1. Parents must rent (or purchase) a violin of appropriate size. More details will be given upon acceptance into the program.
- 2. A \$30 fee paid to Conder will cover all materials including: folder, instrument nametag, composition journal, music book, Conder Strings car magnet, t-shirt rag, collapsible shoulder rest, and other supplies used throughout the year. A colored music stand of your choice color can be added for an additional \$10 (great deal!).
- 3. Concert uniform: white short sleeved polo shirt, dark navy or black pants, a black belt, and black shoes.


